COST OF MEMBERSHIP

INITIAL DEPOSIT

A non refundable deposit is payable with applications for Ordinary and Week-day Membership. This is currently:

- Ordinary Membership: £60.00
- Week-day Membership: £60.00

No deposit is required for Junior and Juvenile Membership applications.

ENTRANCE FEE

To join the Club requires the payment of an entrance fee. This is normally twice the amount of the annual subscription (see below) for the membership category you wish to join.

- Ordinary Entrance Fee £1580.00 (£790 until 31st March 2009)
 - Week-day Entrance Fee £790.00
 - Junior Entrance Fee £198.60 (payable at the time of entry)
- The entrance fee can be paid in one of two ways:
 - The total amount in one lump sum or
 - twelve monthly direct debit payments

ANNUAL SUBSCRIPTION

This is an amount normally set at the Annual General Meeting of the Club to cover the running costs of the Club during the financial year. At the present time the annual subscription is:-

Open to Males and Females aged 18 and above.

- Full voting right
- Full playing rights

WEEK-DAY MEMBERSHIP

Open to Males and Females aged 18 and above.

- Annual subscription 50% of Ordinary Membership subscription
- No voting right
- Restricted playing rights:
- No play to commence after 4.30 p.m. Monday - Friday
- No play at weekends

JUNIOR MEMBERSHIP

Open to Males and Females from 12 to 17 years of age inclusive.

- Annual subscription 25% of Ordinary Membership subscription
- No voting right
- Restricted playing rights:
- No play to commence after 5.00 p.m. Tuesday, Thursday and Friday (except after 1st June when play may commence after 7.00 p.m. on Friday)
- No play to commence between 12.00 noon and 4.00 p.m. Saturday
- No play before 10.30 am on Public and Local Holidays
- Admission only between dates of 12th and 16th birthdays

JUVENILE MEMBERSHIP

Open to Males and Females from 8 to 11 years of age inclusive.

- Flat subscription fee (currently £30.00)
- No entry fee
- No voting right
- Must play with adult member, no visitor rights
- Restricted playing rights:
- Play allowed Wednesday before 4.00 p.m. and after 7.00 p.m., Saturday after 5.00 p.m., Sunday after 4.00 p.m.
- Automatic entry to Junior Membership at 50% entrance fee (provided at least 2 years subscription paid)
- 11 year olds attending secondary school can play in Junior Medals

GUIDANCE NOTES FOR THOSE APPLYING FOR ORDINARY, WEEK-DAY AND JUNIOR MEMBERSHIP

1. In the first instance you should complete Section 'A' of the Application for Membership form. You should then pass the form to your Proposer and Seconder who should complete Section 'B' of the form and return it to the Club Secretary. Please remember that the appropriate non-refundable deposit must accompany your application (Ordinary Membership - £60.00, Week-day Membership £60.00, Junior & Juvenile Membership - no deposit).
2. The Club Secretary will send a letter by return post acknowledging receipt of your application and confirming that your name has been added to the waiting list for membership.
3. As and when a membership place in the category you have chosen becomes available you will be invited to an interview at the Clubhouse. The interview panel will normally consist of the Club Captain, Club Secretary and other members of the Council of Management as deemed appropriate (except for Junior Membership applications where the interview panel will normally consist of the Club's Junior Convener and other members of the Council of Management as deemed appropriate). It is important that your Proposer attends this interview with you to support your application.
4. Following this interview your application will go before the next meeting of the Council of Management of the Club.
5. If your application is successful the Club Secretary will write to you immediately following the Council of Management Meeting offering you membership of the Club and informing you of the financial amount due.
6. On establishment of acceptable payment method you become a member of Cowglen Golf Club and will enjoy the rights and privileges of the membership category you have chosen. All relevant membership documentation will also be provided to you at this time.

GUIDANCE NOTES FOR THOSE APPLYING FOR JUVENILE MEMBERSHIP

1. The adult member wishing to introduce a Juvenile Member should complete all appropriate sections of the 'Application for Membership' form and return it to the Club Secretary.
2. The Club Secretary will send a letter by return post acknowledging receipt of the application and confirming that the Juvenile's name has been added to the waiting list for membership.
3. As and when a membership place becomes available the application will go before the next meeting of the Council of Management of the Club.
4. If the application is successful the Club Secretary will write to the adult member immediately following the Council of Management Meeting offering Juvenile Membership of the Club to the applicant and stating the financial amount due.
5. On receipt of this amount the applicant will become a Juvenile Member of the Cowglen Golf Club. The Club Secretary will provide all relevant membership documentation to the adult member at this time.
